Strategic Decisions

Definition of Strategy (Wikipedia):

A **strategy** is a plan of action designed to achieve a particular goal.



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Response Goals

- Maximize survivability
- Maximize efficient use of resources
- Increase local capacity
- Increase knowledge in the field of professional oiled wildlife response
- Respond safely



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Variables that Affect Response Goals

- When animals are received, spread over weeks or just a few days
- The animals' condition when received
- The type of oil or fuel to which they are exposed
- How long the animals spend in the field
- Number of birds, mammals and reptiles affected
- The skills and experience of the rehabilitation staff
- The resources available to the rehabilitation effort
- Adequacy and availability of facilities
- Cooperation from the regulatory agencies and RP



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Many variables are beyond your control SO...

What CAN you control?

- Facilities
 - size, type, location, water quantity and quality, HVAC, security
- Protocols
- Stabilization facilities
- Response Team



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Considerations in Choosing a Facility

- Species and number of animals involved
- Access to water (quality and quantity)
- Ability to provide heat, cooling, ventilation
- Location of facility
 - accessibility for staff, volunteers
 - Reasonable distance from spill site
 - Located around adequate infrastructure to support needed logistics



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Seminary in Washington State

- Old building with lots of rooms, water
- However...
- No air exchange - only room fans used
 - Aspergillosis caused very high mortality - approximately 90%



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Patagonia Response

Facility was an abandoned poultry slaughter house

- Limited space for stabilization (heat control)
- Water was brought by truck
- Water quality was poor and degraded waterproofing



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Treasure Facility Salt River

- Large enough to house approximately 16,000 penguins
- No heat control
- Several inherent hazards in the building



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Facility Expansion

California Oiled Wildlife Care Network Facility

- Purpose built facility in California
- Designed for approximately 500 oiled birds
- Tents were needed to increase capacity



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Facility Security

Important to consider:

- Keeping animals safe from predators, public
- Security barriers may help limit stress on animals



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Other Facility Considerations

- Sewer and Waste Disposal
- Adequate space for waterproofing pools
- Other Hazardous Waste
 - Oiled boxes
 - Rags
 - Protective clothing
- Telephone, Fax and Internet Access




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Plan of Action (Strategy)



- Initial Assessment
- Recovery & Transportation
- Processing & Intake
- Treatment & Stabilization
- Cleaning
- Conditioning
- Release

Consider all known variables before making a decision



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Ask yourself.....

- How will this effect the animals?
- Will the flow of animals moving through the process be impacted?
- Are there logistical implications with this decision?
- Will this decision help meet response goals?



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Making Critical Decisions to Adapt to the Situation...

- Adapt protocols to situation to meet response goals
- Address forward planning to maximize animal flow through rehabilitation process





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Examples of Adaptation

Treasure Oil Spill Response:

- 20,000 oiled penguins
- Biggest wash day 650 birds
- Rinse time was cut down to 5 minutes per bird to increase number of birds washed per day






To compensate for quick rinse, pool time for all birds was mandatory and increased daily to enable birds to rinse and waterproof themselves.



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Adaptations....


- Feeding boxes designed to move high numbers of animals through feeding process


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Pre-Planning

- Many of the most strategic decisions in a response can be made before an oiling event within the context of a Wildlife Response Plan
- The most *strategic decision* that can be made is the decision to plan for an event!
